

NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING AND AVAILABILITY OF PROPOSED PLAN

PEARL HARBOR SEDIMENT SITE, JOINT BASE PEARL HARBOR-HICKAM, OAHU, HAWAII

The Navy announces a public meeting at the Aiea Elementary School Cafeteria (99-370 Moanalua Road, Aiea, Hawaii) at 7 p.m., February 10, 2016, to discuss the Proposed Plan for the Pearl Harbor Sediment Site, Joint Base Pearl Harbor-Hickam, Oahu, Hawaii. The site is part of the Pearl Harbor Naval Complex National Priorities List Site.

The Navy invites the public to review and comment on the Proposed Plan for the remediation of the Pearl Harbor Sediment site. It has completed its investigation of the Site, identified the nature, extent, and risks associated with contaminated sediments, and developed a plan for remediation. The Navy proposes a combination of focused dredging, enhanced natural recovery, treatment with activated carbon, and monitored natural recovery as the preferred cleanup alternative for the Site. Detailed information on the development, comparative analysis, and selection of the preferred remedy is presented in the Pearl Harbor Sediment Feasibility Study. Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation and Liability Act five-year reviews and long-term monitoring will verify that the remedy continues to protect human health and the environment.
