**Upcoming EPA Environmental Cleanup Action
Former Pesticide Mixing Area
Aalona Place, Kilauea, HI**

Please join us on Thursday, August 2, 2012 for an informational meeting being presented by the Hawai'i State Department of Health, Hazard Evaluation and Emergency Response (HEER) Office and the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) regarding the cleanup action slated to begin August 6th at the former pesticide mixing area on Aalona Place in Kilauea, Kauai. Hawaii's Department of Health Deputy Director Gary Gill, staff from the Hazard Evaluation and Emergency Response Office, and Will Duncan, Federal On Scene Coordinator, for EPA Region 9, will be present to describe what the site investigation discovered, the planned construction activities, what it means for affected residents, workers and community members, and the actions the EPA, State, and Kauai County plans to take to protect public health and the environment.
